Workshop objectives:

(15-20 mins)	<b>Present the Health Data Governance Principles</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Overview of why the Principles were developed, the process for developing them and their intended audience</li> <li>• Presentation of the Principles, including framing, structure and core tenets under each principle</li> </ul>	<a href="#">Presentation of draft Principles</a>
(45-60 mins)	<b>Discussion on introduction, framing and clusters of the Principles (questions 1-5)</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Plenary and/or breakout discussions depending on number of participants and your preference</li> <li>• Use guiding questions to frame the discussion</li> </ul>	<a href="#">Guiding questions</a>
(5-10 mins)	<b>Break</b>	

(45-60 mins)	<b>Discussion on draft Principles (questions 6-13)</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Plenary and/or breakout discussions depending on number of participants and your preference - e.g. each breakout group could discuss one of the clusters of principles (Protect people; Promote health value; or Prioritize equity)</li> <li>• Use guiding questions to frame the discussion</li> </ul>	<a href="#">Guiding questions</a>
(5 mins)	<b>Break</b>	
(20 mins)	<b>Plenary discussion</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Sharing insights from group discussions</li> <li>• Discussion on questions 14-15</li> </ul>	<a href="#">Guiding questions</a>
(10 mins)	<b>Closing</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Explain that the <i>feedback from the workshop will be submitted as part of the Public Consultation (through the online survey)</i></li> <li>• Update that following the Public Consultation, the Principles will be finalised and then launched in early 2022</li> <li>• Encourage participants to help amplify and support the endorsement of the principles by governments and organizations once they are launched</li> <li>• Final closing remarks</li> </ul>
