

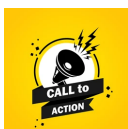
## Youth Network for Digital Health: Concept note

### Overview

With 2.4 billion young people aged 10–29—the largest youth population in history—they hold immense potential to lead the digital transformation of health systems. As rights holders and future duty bearers, their energy, innovation, and vested interest in digital systems are crucial for shaping a sustainable digital health future. However, youth-led actions often occur in silos, limiting their collective impact and visibility on global platforms.

**Transform Health** is building a global movement to achieve Universal Health Coverage (UHC) by 2030 through the equitable, ethical, and enabling use of digital technology and data. As part of this mission, we have integrated Young Experts: Tech for Health (YET4H) into our structures as a dedicated youth initiative of Transform Health. Moving forward, we envision YET4H providing a dynamic platform for youth-led organisations working in digital health and UHC by equipping organisations with opportunities to engage in national and global advocacy, influencing digital health initiatives, and driving policy change. Through Transform Health's six national coalitions in **Kenya, Ecuador, Senegal, India, Indonesia, and Mexico**, youth partners can contribute to digital health policy development and amplify their voices in key decision-making spaces. This combined effort and positioning will increase the influence of young people on some of the most pressing national, regional and global priorities on digital health. ### Objectives of the Network



**Connect, share and learn:** Access to resources, tools and platforms to improve youth leadership and participation in digital health.



**Engage and Contribute:** Ensure meaningful youth engagement in global digital health governance and programming through the Transform Health Coalition.



**Take action:** Develop and implement youth-led advocacy and campaigns to raise awareness about Health Data Governance, Digital Health Investment and other digital health issues.

## Opportunities:

- Engage with the Transform Health National Coalition in your country to shape its strategic direction and support execution of its strategy
- Actively engage in the MyDataOurHealth campaign, advocating for better health data governance and digital health investment.
- Engage with national policymakers on health data governance and digital health investment, advocating for inclusive health policy reforms and interventions.
- Access capacity building activities, enhancing your skills in advocacy, policy design, and digital health innovation.
- Be part of funding proposals and get additional resources for your work (contingent on successful applications).
- Six (6) members will be selected to serve on the Transform Health Youth Council, representing young people and contributing to high-level decision-making processes.
- Opportunity to attend and engage in relevant forums, influencing global health policies and gaining valuable experience

## Member Responsibilities

- Active participation in events and programmes within the Transform Health Coalition.
- Contribution to advocacy and campaign initiatives.
- Represent youth voices within the Coalition and other fora

## Criteria for Membership

Membership in this network is organization-based, not individual. To qualify, an organization must:

- **Geographic Presence:** Be registered and operating in at least one of the six national coalitions in Kenya, Ecuador, Senegal, India, Indonesia, or Mexico.
- **Youth Leadership:** Be youth-led, with leadership consisting of young people below the age of 35 years.
